
Dear Valued Customer,

This letter is regarding the Dangerous Goods shipping requirement, IATA CFR 49, for our portable x-ray tubes (COMET, YXLON, or Andrex: EVO, PXS, Y.SMART product lines). These tubes are filled with pressurized SF6 gas which can be classified as either a Class 9 or Class 2.2 Hazardous Material. In order to transport this tube into the field or back to COMET for repair there are two compliant ways to ship these tubes.

We have introduced a new method (Class 9 distinction) which is easier and more cost effective to implement. Using the Class 9 distinction, shipments are less likely to be impacted by shipping delays and clearance holds. The original method of shipping our DG tubes is still possible until December 31st 2021 to ease the transition to the new preferred method of shipping.

The customer is no longer required to label the tube with DOT-SP 20221 stickers if. Any Class 2.2 and Dangerous Goods stickers (green) are no longer required. All such stickers should be removed prior to shipping a Class 9 system.
